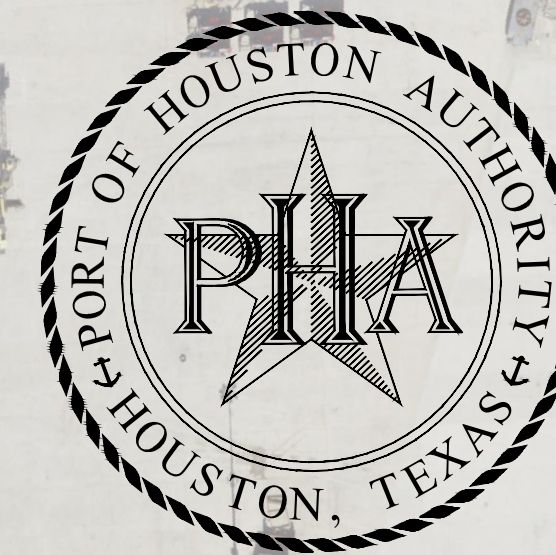
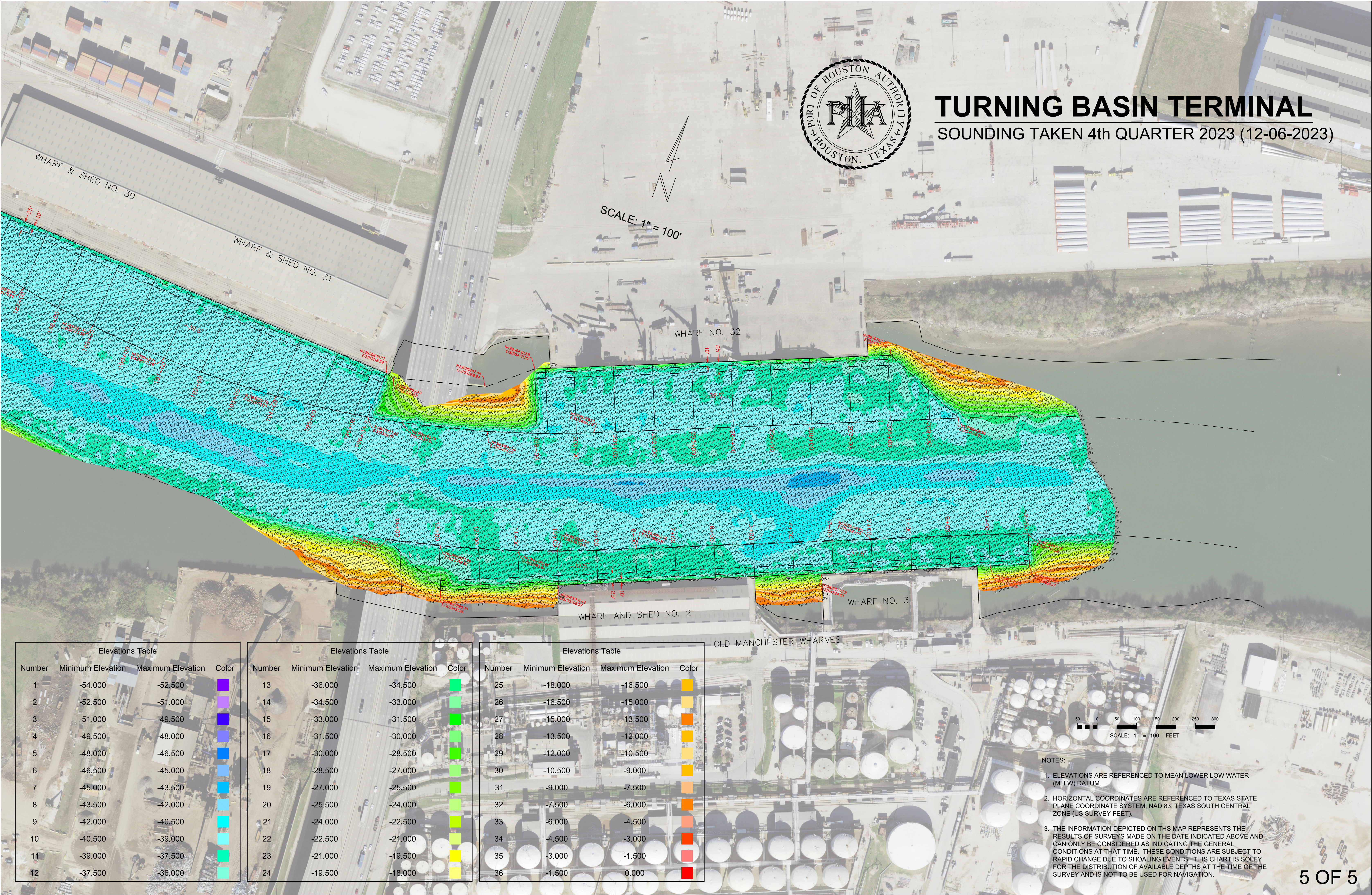




TURNING BASIN TERMINAL

SOUNDING TAKEN 4th QUARTER 2023 (12-06-2023)

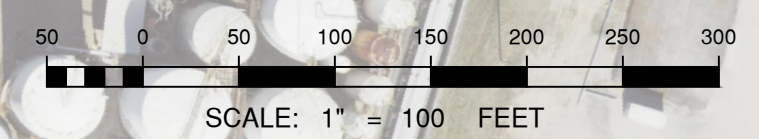
