Time is money. And that's why we want to get you through Port terminals efficiently and on the road to your next destination. Using Express Pass is the BEST way to ensure quick turns and smooth Port pickups and drop-offs.

Beginning December 2 Express Pass will be required for all lanes at our container terminals.

- If you do not have an Express Pass you will need to leave and return when you have one ready.
- Strongly recommend creating a reservation in advance – by 6 p.m. the previous day – to prevent delay.
- Express Pass will be VALID for the day it was requested only – you can plan to 72 hrs. in advance
- Highly recommend LP# present on the front of the cab for quicker service
- License & Chassis Optional – use Trucking Co. SCAC if needed.

Restrictions

- No IDOs
- An Express Pass is required for each move
- Daily Chassis Rules Apply
- Daily Empty Rules Apply

Express Pass is a timeless appointment system that allows trucking companies to initiate trucker transactions prior to arriving at Port Houston's Bayport and Barbours Cut Container Terminals. When using Express Pass, truck drivers also have access to dedicated Express Pass lanes and automated entrance to the terminal.

- **Reduces ingate transaction time to 15 seconds or less**
- **Eliminates the need for operator interactions, shortening transaction time**
- **Minimizes trouble tickets instances**
- **Minimizes truck turn times by allowing for advanced yard planning**
