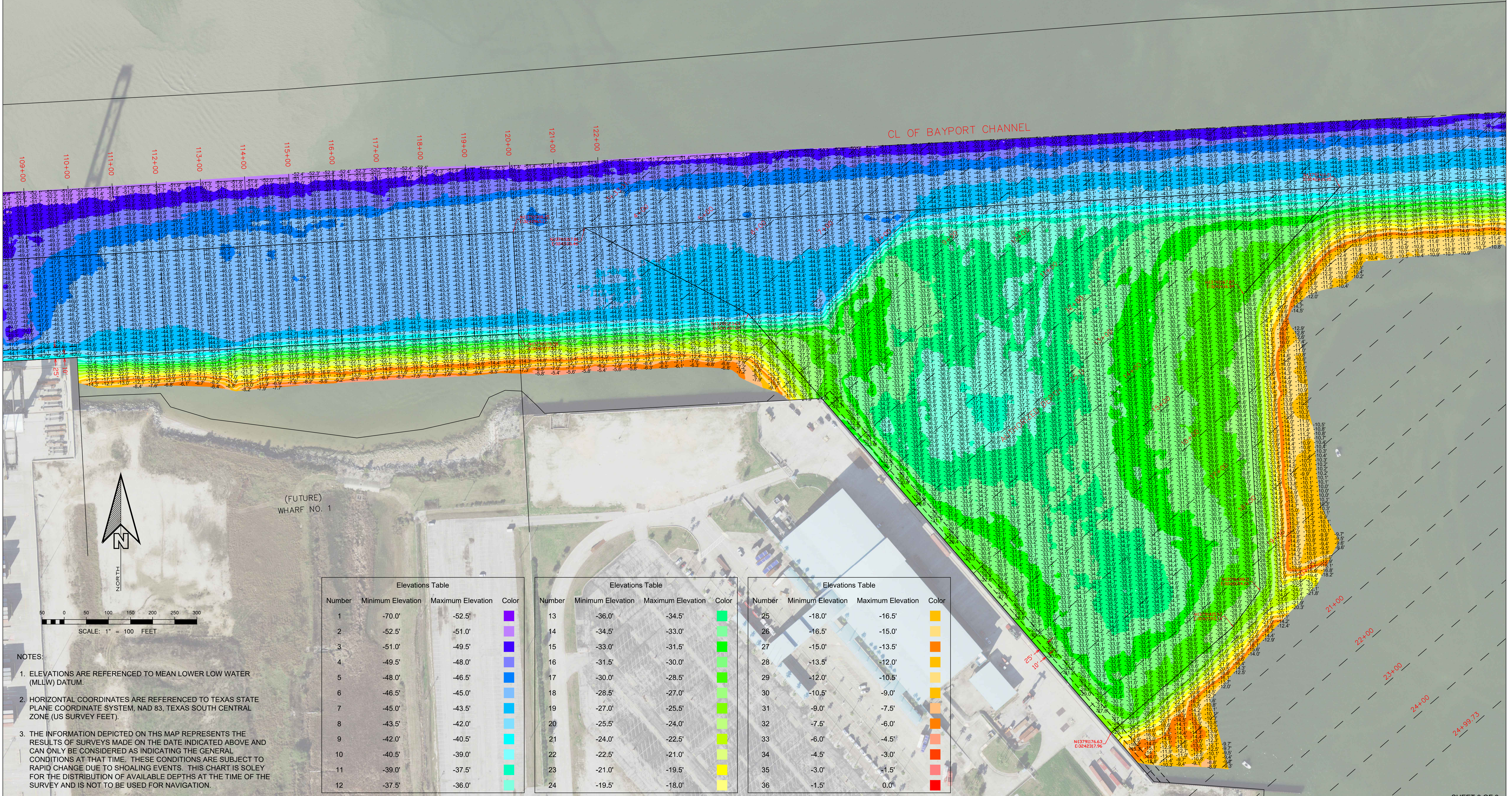


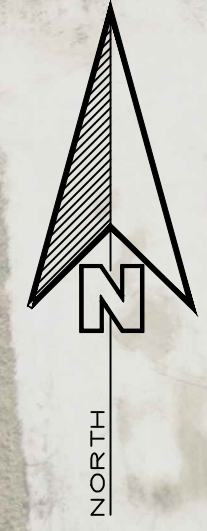


# BAYPORT TERMINAL
