## Houston International Maritime Conference (HIMC) Announces Jim Teague as Honoree of the 3rd Annual Port Houston Lone Star Award

His career began in service to the nation during the Vietnam War, where he served in an attack helicopter squadron and as a Naval intelligence officer, before transitioning to Dow Chemicals and ultimately Enterprise Products.

This year's HIMC program will feature influential sessions on topics shaping world trade and maritime operations, including Panama Canal updates, the tariff effect on sourcing and infrastructure, innovations in energy and petrochemicals, and digitalization in tanker shipping. Beyond the panels, HIMC is a premier networking opportunity, connecting executives, policymakers, and industry leaders from around the globe.

Mr. Teague will deliver a keynote address on November 3 at 3:10 p.m., followed by his recognition as the 2025 Lone Star Award honoree.
